Government of India has notified four Labour Codes on 21st November, 2025 in order to simplify and consolidate the labour laws in India. New Labour Codes have replaced existing 29 labour laws. These Labour Laws were centuries old and had become obsolete and irrelevant in 21st century industrial environment. Hence Central Government has taken revolutionary step of codifying 29 laws into four codes. While formulating Government of India has taken care of the interest of the workers as well the industrial & economic development of the country.

Implementation of Labor Codes will pave the way for the rapid industrialization of the country.
